General Information

What is APEX Convention?

APEX Convention is AGO's Centennial Founders Day Celebration and the largest gathering in the fraternity's history. Brothers, families, and supporters from across the country will come together to celebrate 100 years of Alpha Gamma Omega and help launch its next century of impact.

When and where is APEX Convention?

February 26–28, 2027
Marriott Long Beach Downtown
Long Beach, California

Who is invited?

Undergraduate members, alumni, spouses and family members, parents and supporters of AGO, ADX and AGO Little Sisters, and friends of the fraternity.

I haven't been involved with AGO in years. Is this still for me?

Absolutely. Many attendees will be returning to AGO events for the first time in years. APEX Convention is designed to reconnect brothers across generations, celebrate our shared history, and build relationships for the future.

Will there be brothers from my era attending?

We certainly hope so. One of the primary goals of APEX Convention is to bring together multiple generations of AGO men in one place.

Registration

What does registration include?

Friday evening fellowship opportunities, Saturday convention programming, industry and life-stage networking opportunities, breakfast, lunch, and dinner, the Centennial Gala, and convention materials and attendee resources.

Can I attend only part of the weekend?

Yes. Registration grants access to the full APEX Convention experience, but attendees are welcome to participate in as much of the weekend as their schedule allows.

Is there student pricing?

Yes. Discounted registration rates are available for undergraduate members.

I am a minister or missionary. Is there a special registration rate?

Can I bring my spouse?

Yes. Spouses and family members are encouraged to attend and participate in designated convention activities.

Does my spouse need their own registration?

Yes. Every attendee must have their own registration unless they are included through a registration option that specifically includes a guest.

Hotel & Travel

Is there a hotel room block?

Yes. AGO is working with the Marriott Long Beach Downtown to provide a room block for convention attendees.

How do I reserve a room?

Attendees will reserve their own rooms directly through the hotel using the room block information provided by AGO.

Will AGO book my room for me?

No. Attendees are responsible for making their own hotel reservations.

Centennial Gala

What is the dress code?

The Centennial Gala is coat and tie. Business formal attire is encouraged. A tuxedo is not required.
